## ABOUT THE ARTIST



Pam's latest series of paintings portray the Australian landscape, from vast expanses of deserts to small close-up sections of flood bound riverbeds or the destruction of our native forests.

The changing face of the land, whether by nature or man, are areas which lie close to her heart. She combines her love of travel with drawing – always travelling with a sketchbook – capturing the moment, whether it's drawing animals on a safari in Africa, the Australian coastal coves and marinas, outback desert ruins or Antarctic vistas.

"I paint with a bold often vigorous contemporary style – at times quite minimal. Often I just want to capture the reflections or pattern of a section of the landscape ... the larger picture becoming secondary."

Pam has held 8 solo exhibitions of painting or sculpture and is represented in corporate, private and public collections, locally, interstate and overseas and has won prizes for her work in all mediums.

She has a Diploma of Fine Art from the Brisbane Institute of Art and her studio is in Coolum Beach, Queensland.
